Bus

Reach most of Dubai landmarks and connects the majority of the attractions. It is less

frequent than the Metro but still very reliable and relatively cheap.

Taxi

Very easy to find in the city, especially near the main attractions.

Abras

Sort of traditional wooden water-taxis, the best way to cross Dubai Creek.

Please note that in Dubai, women have different sitting arrangements. On the bus, they sit in front seats of the buses, and on the Metro and Tram, they have special cabins. There are also "Pink Taxis" driven by women and for women and families only.



Together they create two 150 meters towers connected by 93 meters Sky Deck that display a breathtaking panoramic view of the city. More than that, the Frame is aiming to present Dubai's history, progress, and dreams. It does so with 3 different eye-catching galleries that tell the story of Dubai from

the days of the past, to present times and its aspirations for the future.
