

## ① Eiffel Tower, Paris

## ⑦ Arc de Triomphe, Paris

Beneath it lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, where the eternal Flame of Remembrance is rekindled daily at 18:30. Climb to the top for a breathtaking panoramic view of Paris, with twelve grand avenues radiating from its base like a star.


