### ② 09:00 - 09:30 **Trocadéro Gardens, Paris**

Pl. du Trocadéro et du 11 Novembre, 75016 Paris, France

Trocadéro Gardens offers one of the most spectacular views of the Eiffel Tower. Located across the Seine, these elegant gardens feature grand fountains, sculptures, and lush greenery. A perfect spot for photos, relaxing strolls, and enjoying the mesmerizing Parisian landscape.

The Trocadéro Gardens, originally created for the 1878 Paris World's Fair, were redesigned for the 1937 Exposition Universelle, spanning an impressive 94,000 sqm. The gardens' highlight is the stunning Fountain of Warsaw, featuring cascading water terraces and powerful cannons that frame breathtaking views of the Eiffel Tower. At the top, the Palais de Chaillot—built on the ruins of the original Palais du Trocadéro—houses museums, a theater, a café, and a fine restaurant. Nestled within

the gardens, the Aquarium de Paris offers an exciting marine experience, making it a fantastic stop for families exploring the area.

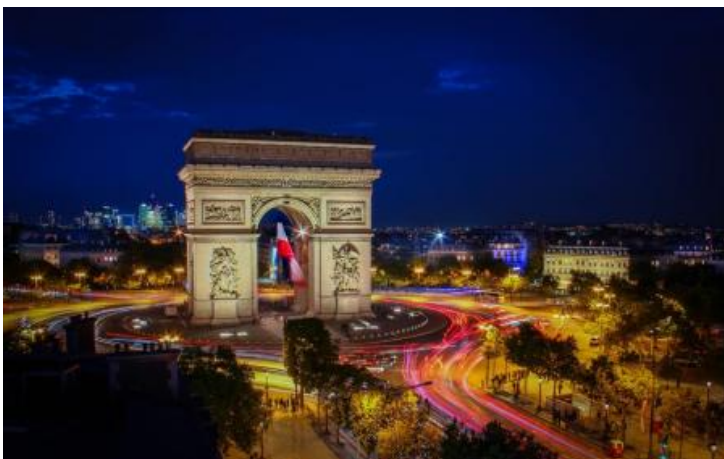

**8 16:30 - 17:30 Arc de Triomphe, Paris**

The Arc de Triomphe stands as a powerful tribute to France's military history and a defining symbol of Paris. 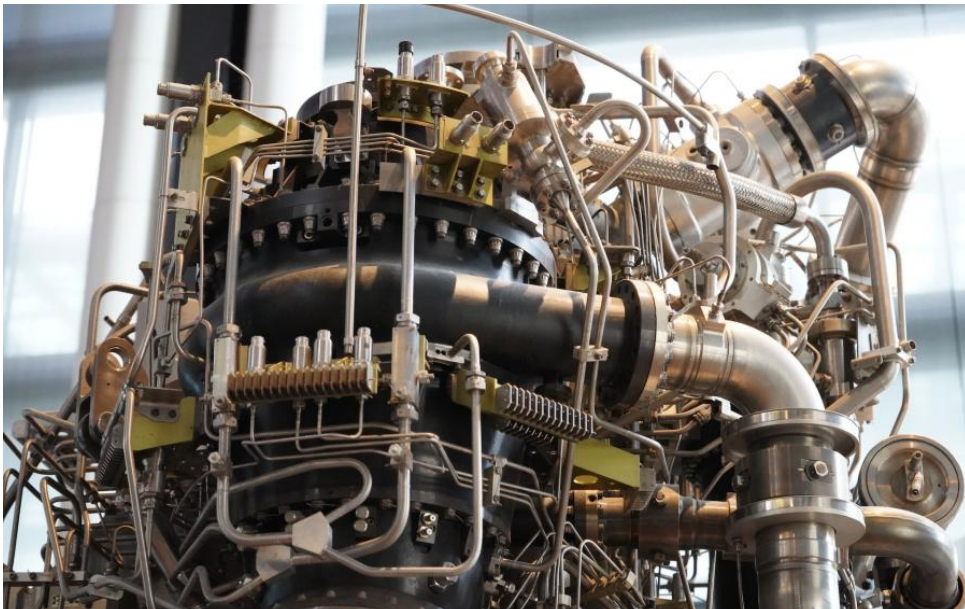
